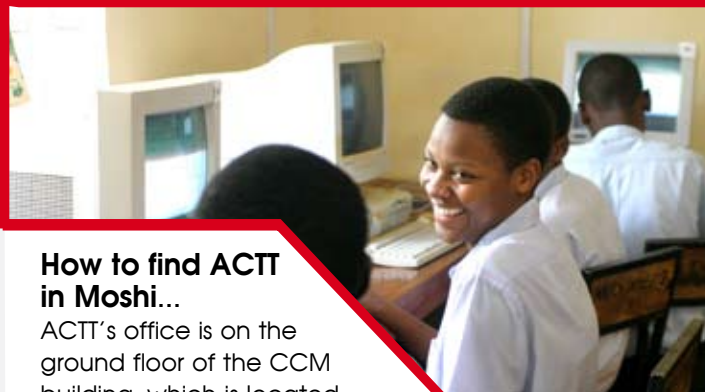

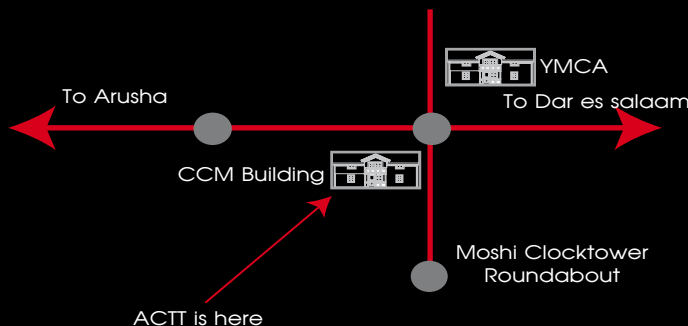

affordable computers and technology for Tanzania

Empowering Tanzania's youth with IT products, skills and education.



Affordable Computers and Technology for Tanzania (ACTT) sells computers that have been refurbished by street youth who live at Mkombozi and have been trained as hardware and software technicians. The refurbished computers are sold at a discounted rate to schools, businesses and not-for-profit organisations throughout Tanzania to promote information technology (IT), to enhance education, to create employment opportunities, and to assist older street youth to transition to independent living.

### ACTT's mission:

To contribute to the alleviation of poverty in Tanzania by empowering youth with IT products, skills and education which enable them to access opportunities to become independent, well rounded, inquiring and productive adults.



### ACTT's vision:

To sustain and deepen the impact of Mkombozi's practice with Tanzania's vulnerable children by raising money to support Mkombozi's residential care services for street children and by educating and increasing the self-sufficiency of youth.

### ACTT's objectives:

- To support the establishment and operation of sustainable computer labs across Tanzania.
- To provide affordable hardware, training and PC maintenance to Tanzanians.
- To provide IT training for children and youth.
- To create opportunities for employment among Tanzania's youth.
- To generate funds for the delivery of Mkombozi's child / youth care services.
- To sensitise policymakers, educationalists and the public about the potential of IT.

## ACTT's Products and Services

### Computer hardware sales:

ACTT sells high-quality, refurbished Personal Computers (PCs) to educational institutions, nongovernment organisations, civil society organisations and individuals within Tanzania. Hardware includes desktops, printers, monitors, keyboards, mice, cables and other peripherals. Although various packages are available to suit the needs and budget of each customer, minimum system specifications include Pentium II processors @ 266Mhz, 64Mb RAM and 4Gb hard drives.

### PC installation and follow-up:

ACTT trained technicians are available to install and configure ACTT computers at the customer's site, at no extra cost. ACTT is also willing to do a pre-installation visit to provide advice on the adequate preparation of that site for optimal PC performance. ACTT always offers a 3 month follow-up visit to the customer's site, to ensure that ACTT computers are problem-free.

### PC maintenance:

ACTT offers one-year software and hardware maintenance contracts to ACTT customers. This includes regular 3-month, onsite PC cleaning, check-ups and troubleshooting as well as emergency service (i.e. telephone support and, if necessary, onsite visits). ACTT also troubleshoots and repairs non-ACTT PCs that are delivered to the ACTT workshop.

### IT skills training:

ACTT provides a variety of IT skills training courses, available to a broad spectrum of clients. Current course offerings include:

- Certificate in Computer Operation / Awareness
- Certificate in Microsoft Office Expert (Standardised)
- Certificate in Computer Technician
- Certificate in Computer Graphics Design
- Certificate in Computerised Accounting
- Certificate in Networking



### Apprenticeships for vulnerable youth:

ACTT offers much-needed apprenticeships (3 months or 1 year in duration) to street children, children at Mkombozi's residential care centre, youth who have dropped out of primary school, as well as graduates of vocational training and secondary schools. ACTT apprenticeships empower youth to compete for employment opportunities by gaining workplace skills and confidence.

Did you know that more than 80% of Tanzanian schools are located in rural areas, that less than 30% of schools have electricity, and that less than 5% have computers? Tanzania is at risk of marginalisation in the information age.
